- 1 My son, forget not my law; but let your heart keep my commandments:
- 2 For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to you. Deut 8:1; Deut 30:20;
- 3 Let not mercy and truth forsake you: bind them about your neck; write them on the table of your heart: Exod 13:9; Deut 6:8;
- 4 So shall you find favor and good understanding in the sight of God and man.
- 5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart; and lean not to your own understanding.
- 6 In all your ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct your paths. 1Chr 28:9;
- 7 Be not wise in your own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil. Rom 12:16;
- 8 It shall be health to your navel, and marrow to your bones.
- 9 Honor the LORD with your substance, and with the first fruits of all your increase: Exod 23:19; Exod 34:26; Deut 26:2; Mal 3:10; Luke 14:13;
- 10 So shall your barns be filled with plenty, and your presses shall burst out with new wine. Deut 28:8;
- 11 My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD; neither be weary of his correction: Job 5:17; Heb 12:5;
- 12 For whom the LORD loves he corrects; even as a father the son in whom he delights. Rev 3:19;
- 13 Happy is the man that finds wisdom, and the man that gets understanding.
- 14 For the merchandise of it is better than the merchandise of silver, and the gain thereof than fine gold. Job 28:15; Ps 19:10; Prov 8:11; Prov 8:19; Prov 16:16;
- 15 She is more precious than rubies: and all the things you can desire are not to be compared to her. Prov 8:11;
- 16 Length of days is in her right hand; and in her left hand riches and honor.
- 17 Her ways are ways of pleasantness, and all her paths are peace.
- 18 She is a tree of life to them that lay hold on her: and happy is every one that retains her.
- 19 The LORD by wisdom has founded the earth; by understanding has he established the heavens.
- 20 By his knowledge the depths are broken up, and the clouds drop down the dew. Gen 1:9-10;
- 21 My son, let not them depart from your eyes: keep sound wisdom and discretion:
- 22 So shall they be life to your soul, and grace to your neck.
- 23 Then shall you walk in your way safely, and your foot shall not stumble. Ps 37:24; Ps 91:11-12;
- 24 When you lie down, you shall not be afraid: yes, you shall lie down, and your sleep shall be sweet. Lev 6:26; Job 11:19; Ps 3:5; Ps 4:8; Ps 91:5-6;
- 25 Be not afraid of sudden fear, neither of the desolation of the wicked, when it comes.
- 26 For the LORD shall be your confidence, and shall keep your foot from being taken.
- 27 Withhold not good from them to whom it is due, when it is in the power of your hand to do it.
- 28 Say not to your neighbor, Go, and come again, and to morrow I will give; when you have it by you.
- 29 Devise not evil against your neighbor, seeing he dwells securely by you.
- 30 Strive not with a man without cause, if he have done you no harm.
- 31 Envy you not the oppressor, and choose none of his ways. Ps 37:1; Ps 73:3; Prov 23:17;
- 32 For the fraudulent is abomination to the LORD: but his secret is with the righteous. Ps 25:14;
- 33 The curse of the LORD is in the house of the wicked: but he blesses the habitation of the just. Lev 26:14; Deut 28:15; Mal 2:2;
- 34 Surely he scorns the scorers: but he gives grace to the lowly. Jas 4:6; 1Pet 5:5;
- 35 The wise shall inherit glory: but shame shall be the promotion of fools.
